Wk 3: July 5-7 (mini) (Tues. – Thurs.)



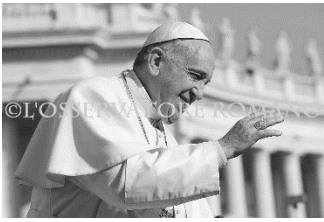
Registration Cost: Weeks 1 & 2 @ \$95 / wk., Week 3 @ \$70

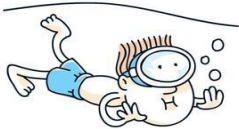
