New Things Happening at Holy Trinity:

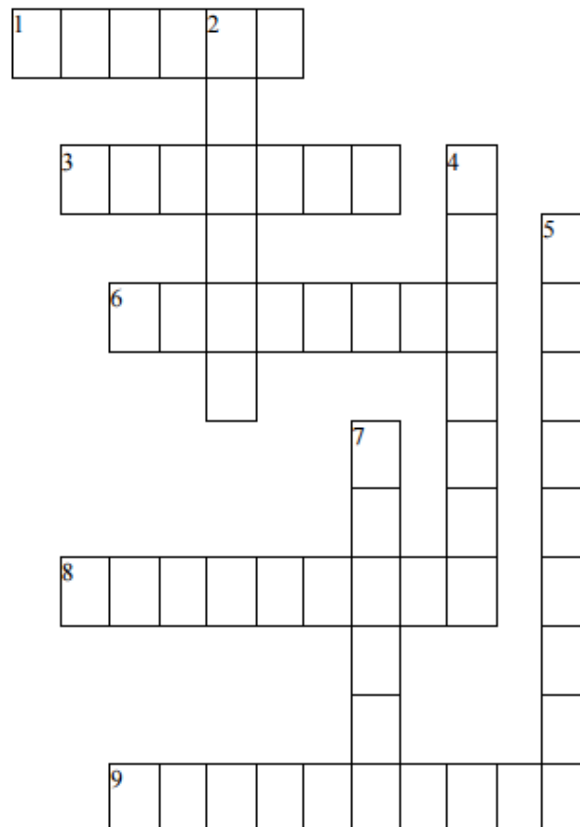
