## From the Desk of the Pastor

Dear Friends in Christ,

Recall when Jesus said: "I no longer call you servants but friends." As we think on those words, or the words of the Lord spoken to us by the prophet Isaiah, who said "I have carved you in the palm of my hand," we may be struck with disbelief. I'm not that livable, is what that voice within may say.

To counter that voice of disbelief I want to quote for you the words of Fr Henri Nouwen. "Over the years, I have come to realize that the greatest trap in our life is not success, popularity, or power, but self-rejection. Success, popularity, and power can indeed present a great temptation, but their seductive quality often comes from the way they are part of the much larger temptation to self-rejection. When we have come to believe in the voices that call us worthless and unlovable, then success, popularity, and power are easily perceived as attractive solutions.

The real trap, however, is self-rejection. As soon as someone accuses me or criticizes me, as soon as I am rejected, left alone, or abandoned, I find myself thinking, "Well, that proves once again that I am a nobody." ... [My dark side says,] I am no good... I deserve to be pushed aside, forgotten, rejected, and abandoned. Self-rejection is the greatest enemy of the spiritual life because it contradicts the sacred voice that calls us the "Beloved." Being the Beloved constitutes the core truth of our existence."

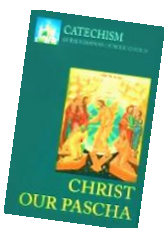

**June #2: Excerpt from Christ Our Pascha: Structure of the Catechism:**

Part Two of the Catechism develops the liturgical understanding of Christ's Passover, based upon the words of Christ's institution of the Eucharist at the Mystical Supper [Last Supper] and as cited by the Anaphora. This is the Eucharistic heart from which proceed all the cycles of the Church's liturgical prayer (daily, weekly, yearly); from which flow the Holy Mysteries on their celebration; and from which spiritual life is born, and devotion flourishes.
