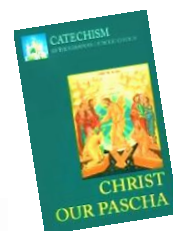

Vital Stats: \$1,871 was offered in the collection with another \$104 for candles, \$40 for the Eparchy, \$69 for utilities, \$10 for Ascension, \$90 for Pentecost, \$36 for Natalia Protynyak in Ukraine Fund, \$25 for UGCC Mission, \$10 for prosphora, \$315 for a grave foundation order, and \$510 for the Kitchen fund, all for a grand total of \$3,080. The Pyrohi Project brought in a “net amount” of \$1,067. Many blessings to all of our contributors whose sacrificial giving is known by God.
