New Things Happening:

- **New “TEMPORARY” Liturgy Schedule for the month of August and first week in September: 10AM BI-LINGUAL.** In an attempt to bring our parish together as one body we'll be celebrating Sunday Liturgies only at 10am from August 2nd through September 6th inclusive. Mr. Stephen Zinski will be directing our choir. Initially we are going to do the first half of the Liturgy using Slavonic, second half of the Liturgy using English. This is a work in progress, and we can amend it as we go along should there be need.
